

## **AHSC AFP Innovation Fund**

# **IFPOC Criteria/Eligibility:**

- Have a definite potential to **impact** health care delivery
- Are **implementable** and contains realistic goals
- Have clear, **measurable** metrics for success
- Offer opportunities to translate new knowledge into medical practice
- Are **transferable** to other institutions, or regions, or the province

#### **SEAMO Rules:**

- 1. The Project Lead or Principal Investigator (PI) must be a SEAMO-funded physician
- 2. In any one application there can be one PI and as many Co-PIs as desired
- 3. An individual can be named as PI/Co-PI in no more than one application in any given year
- 4. SEAMO physicians cannot apply to the Innovation Fund if they have also applied to or are current recipients of ERESF funding
- 5. Applicants may apply for project funding up to \$150,000 (in total) for projects to be completed within two years. Please visit <a href="http://www.ifpoc.org/">http://www.ifpoc.org/</a> for information regarding eligible expenses
- 6. Funding will not be provided for the development of stand-alone databases without an associated, clearly defined research plan
- 7. A detailed budget request, with justification, will be an integral part of the application
- 8. Should a project's implementation require the support of individuals or institutions (such as hospitals), a letter of support should be included with the proposal. Letters of support will be counted in the total page count.
- 9. Investigators who received monies from the Innovation Fund for two projects in the last five consecutive years will not be eligible to apply to this competition
- 10. Funds will generally not be awarded for subject participation. Costs related to results, presentation and travel will be limited to \$2,000
- 11. While multi-centre collaborations are encouraged, the expectation for this award is that the great majority of funds will be expended within Kingston
- 12. Total page count for the application cannot exceed 15 pages (excluding key words)
- 13. Applications requesting a continuation of previous funding are not in the spirit of innovation and therefore, are not eligible
- 14. Generally speaking, requests for capital equipment will not be considered

# **Competition Categories:**

• Two categories of simultaneous competitions:



- Group A: Early investigators (first seven years of career)
- o Group B: Established researchers (greater than seven years in career)

## **Project Categories:**

- These categories are used to aid in building a well-rounded adjudication committee and match knowledgeable reviewers with the most optimal projects:
  - Prospective clinical trial including a pilot/feasibility assessment
  - o Novel technique, technology, or imaging assessment
  - Observational statistical project, population-based, administrative dataset, longitudinal cohort study, cross-sectional
  - o Descriptive clinic, care delivery, or navigation innovation
  - Quality Improvement
  - o Qualitative research or survey-based projects
  - o Basic science, translational, or biomarker development projects
  - o Projects with AI, machine learning, digital health as the methodology
  - Other please elaborate

#### **Innovation Fund Review Committee**

- Committee Chair and two Scientific Officers oversee the process
- A college of reviewers is formed internally with two reviewers and one reader assigned to each project submission
- Using the above project categories, projects will be assigned to reviewers based on areas of expertise (pending availability), but neither the reviewers nor the reader will have a conflict of interest with their assigned project lead
- All reviewers will attend the adjudication meeting to discuss applications at a round table and decide on a final score
- All applicants, regardless of outcome, will receive their score and feedback following the adjudication process

### **The Adjudication Process**

- A Letter of Intent must be submitted by Friday, September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at midnight and needs to include the following information:
  - o The Project Title
  - The Names of the PI and Co-PIs
  - o The Competition Category the PI falls under
  - The Project Category that best describes this application



- o A brief statement justifying why this project is innovative
- o Canadian Common CV for both PI and Co-PIs
- Full applications are due on September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at midnight
- Recommendations are sent to IFPOC in the first week of January
- Approval is provided by IFPOC in the first week of March
- Successful applicants will be notified in early March or as soon as we hear from IFPOC
